

Deafness is also an invisible wall that separates the deaf-mute from family and society. Because of deafness, they cannot hear, cannot understand and cannot sympathize with others. Because of muteness, they cannot speak, cannot express their thoughts and wishes to others. Because they do not understand others and are not understood and sympathized with by others, it is easy to misunderstand and become increasingly distant from others. Jesus showed sympathy for the deaf-mute's situation. He took action to break down the wall of deafness for the patient, allowing him to hear, speak and sympathize with others, and vice versa, others could easily hear and sympathize with him. The miracle did not focus on the physical healing of the man who was both deaf and mute. Rather, the miracle focused on opening his ears so that he could hear the Word of God and untying his tongue so that he could profess his faith in Jesus. A person can hear well, but not listen to the Word of God. A person can speak fluently but cannot profess faith.

Chúa Nhật XXIII Thường Niên B

Bệnh câm điệc cũng chính là bức tường vô hình ngăn cách kẻ câm điếc với gia đình và xã hội. Vì điếc nên không thể nghe, không thể hiểu và không thể cảm thông với tha nhân. Vì câm nên không thể nói, không thể diễn tả tâm tư nguyện vọng của mình cho người khác hiểu. Vì không hiểu người khác và không được người khác hiểu, thông cảm nên dễ sinh ra hiểu lầm và ngày càng xa cách người khác. Đức Giêsu đã tỏ ra cảm thông với hoàn cảnh của người câm điếc. Người ra tay phá bỏ bức tường ngăn cách là bênh câm điếc này cho bênh nhân, khiến anh ta lai có thể nghe được, nói được và cảm thông được với người khác, và ngược lai, người khác cũng dễ dàng nghe và hiểu biết thông cảm với anh.
