

XXIVSunday in Ordinary Time

Who is Jesus? This is a question that was asked not only during the time when Jesus was on earth, but also in our own time. The question was asked not only out of curiosity to know what public opinion thought about the character of Jesus, but it was asked to wait for an answer that would have a decisive influence on the way of life of the person answering.

In the past, many Jews answered that Jesus was just someone like the prophets, like Elijah, like John or like any other prophet. According to them, prophets were people who, although they preached a good doctrine, although they did some extraordinary things, they often disturbed their peaceful life. Therefore, when they did not want to be disturbed anymore, they did not hesitate to kill the prophets: they hunted down Elijah, they imprisoned Jeremiah, they beheaded John the Baptist and they also crucified Jesus.

Peter replied that Jesus was the Christ, meaning a person who was capable of saving his life and worthy of being followed until his last breath. That is why, although following the Master meant denying himself and carrying the cross, Peter was ready to be faithful to the Master until death.

Chúa Nhật XXIV Thường Niên B

Đức Giêsu là ai? Đó là một câu hỏi được đặt ra không phải chỉ trong thời Đức Giêsu còn ở dưới thế, mà còn được đặt ra ngay trong thời đại chúng ta ngày nay. Câu hỏi được đặt ra không phải chỉ vì tò mò muốn biết dư luận nghĩ sao về nhân vật Giêsu, nhưng nó được đặt ra để chờ đợi một câu trả lời có ảnh hưởng quyết định trên lối sống của người trả lời.

Ngày xưa, nhiều người Do thái trả lời rằng Giêsu cũng chỉ là một người nào đó như các tiên tri, như Êlia, như Gioan hay như bất cứ một tiên tri nào khác. Mà theo họ nghĩ, tiên tri là những người tuy rao giảng một giáo thuyết hay, tuy làm được một số việc lạ lùng hơn người, nhưng nhiều khi cũng quấy rầy cuộc sống bình an của họ. Bởi thế khi không muốn bị quấy rầy nữa thì họ không ngại giết chết các tiên tri: họ đã lùng bắt Êlia, họ đã bỏ tù Giêrêmia, họ đã chém đầu Gioan tẩy giả và họ cũng đã đóng đinh Giêsu. Riêng Phêrô thì trả lời rằng Giêsu chính là Đức Kitô, nghĩa là một người có thừa khả năng để cứu rỗi đời mình và đáng cho mình đi theo cho đến hơi thở cuối cùng. Chính vì thế mặc dù muốn theo Thầy thì phải bỏ mình vác thập giá, nhưng Phêrô đã sẵn sàng trung thành với Thầy cho đến chết.


