

In this Sunday's Gospel, on the way to Capernaum, Jesus' disciples are arguing about who is the greatest. The disciples are still unclear about Jesus and his mission. Even when Jesus foretells a second time that he will be betrayed and that death awaits him in Jerusalem, they continue to dream of sharing in his glory, when he claims to be the biblical Messiah. In our time, humility is the most misunderstood virtue. Humility is seen as weakness. Being humble does not mean being pushed around by subordinates or living with an inferiority complex. Humility is not like that. Humble people know their position and accept it. If humble people are asked to rule, they will do so. When they are asked to serve others, they will serve. But even in their most glorious days, the humble person always remembers that all that they are or have comes from God.

Many migrants experience God as their traveling companion, guide and anchor of salvation. They entrust themselves to him before setting out and seek him in times of need. In him, they find consolation in moments of discouragement. God not only walks with his people, but also within them, in the sense that he identifies himself with men and women on their journey through history, particularly with the least, the poor and the marginalized.

For this reason, the encounter with the migrant, as with every brother and sister in need, "is also an encounter with Christ. He himself said so. It is he who knocks on our door, hungry, thirsty, an outsider, naked, sick and imprisoned, asking to be met and assisted"

Chúa Nhật XXV Thường Niên B

Trong bài Tin Mừng Chúa Nhật tuần này, trên đường đi đến Ca-pha-na-um, các môn đệ của Chúa Giêsu đang tranh luân với nhau để xem ai là người lớn nhất. Các môn đệ vẫn còn chưa rõ ngọn ngành về Chúa Giêsu và sứ vụ của Người. Ngay cả khi Chúa tiên báo lần thứ hai về việc Người sẽ bị phản bội và cái chết đang chờ Người ở Giêrusalem thì ho vẫn tiếp tục mơ mông sẽ được chia sẻ vinh quang của Người, khi Người tuyên bổ mình là Đầng Mêsia trong Thánh Kinh. Trong thời đại của chúng ta, khiêm nhường là nhân đức bị hiểu lầm nhiều nhất. Khiêm nhường bị coi như là sự yếu đuối. Sống khiêm nhường không có nghĩa là để thuộc cấp chèn ép hay sống theo mặc cảm tự ti. Khiêm nhường không phải là như thế. Con người khiêm nhường biết chỗ đứng của mình và đứng vào chỗ đó. Nếu người khiêm nhường được yêu cầu đứng ra điều khiển, cai tri, ho sẽ làm việc đó. Khi ho được yêu cầu phục vụ kẻ khác, họ sẽ phục vụ. Nhưng cả trong những ngày giờ huy hoàng nhất, người khiêm nhường luôn nhớ rằng tất cả những gì mình là, hay mình có đều đến từ Thiên Chúa.
