Gospel Reflection

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes – the charter of the Kingdom of Heaven. What is surprising is that those whom Jesus blesses are not the wealthy, powerful, or successful according to worldly standards, but the poor, the meek, the sorrowful, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, and those persecuted for righteousness' sake.

Jesus invites us to change our perspective on happiness. True happiness does not lie in possessing wealth, fame, or power, but in a living relationship with God, knowing how to place our complete trust in Him. The poor in spirit are those who are aware of their own fragility and rely on God rather than on their own strength. The Beatitudes are also the path to following Jesus. He himself lived these beatitudes fully: meek, merciful, humble, and willing to suffer for the love of humanity. Therefore, living the Beatitudes is not something far-fetched, but the Christian way of life in everyday life.

Suy Niệm Tin Mừng

Trong bài Tin Mừng hôm nay, Chúa Giêsu công bố Tám Mối Phúc Thật – bản hiến chương của Nước Trời. Điều gây ngạc nhiên là: những người được Chúa chúc phúc lại không phải là kẻ giàu có, quyền lực hay thành công theo tiêu chuẩn thế gian, mà là người nghèo khó, hiền lành, sầu khổ, khao khát công chính, xót thương, trong sạch, kiến tạo hòa bình và bị bách hại vì sống công chính.

Chúa Giêsu mời gọi chúng ta đổi cách nhìn về hạnh phúc. Hạnh phúc thật không hề tại ở việc sở hữu nhiều của cải, danh vọng hay quyền lực, nhưng ở mối tương quan sống động với Thiên Chúa, biết đặt trọn niềm tin nơi Ngài. Người nghèo khó trong tinh thần là người ý thức thân phận mong manh của mình, biết cậy dựa vào Chúa hơn là vào sức riêng.

Tám Mối Phúc cũng là con đường theo Chúa Giêsu. Chính Ngài đã sống trọn vẹn những mối phúc ấy: hiền lành, xót thương, khiêm nhường và sẵn sàng chịu đau khổ vì yêu thương con người. Vì thế, sống Tám Mối Phúc không phải là điều xa vời, nhưng là lối sống Kitô hữu giữa đời thường.
