Gospel Reflection

Dear brothers and sisters, as we enter the First Sunday of Lent, the Liturgy leads us into the desert, where Jesus fasted for forty days and was tempted before beginning his ministry. The desert is a place of silence, trial, and purification. It is also an image of each of our own lives. The Gospel recounts three temptations that Jesus faced: the temptation of material things, the temptation of fame, and the temptation of power. Today's desert can represent moments of loneliness, failure, or inner struggles between good and evil. Following Jesus' example, we overcome temptation by: fervent prayer, fasting and sacrifice, diligently reading and living the Word of God, and performing acts of charity towards our brothers and sisters.

Lent is not a season of sadness, but a season of return. A return to God, the true source of life; a return to ourselves to recognize our weaknesses that need purification; and a return to others through concrete love.

FASTING & ABSTINENCE

When do I...? Fast and Abstain: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday
Abstain: All Fridays during Lent

What is...? Fasting: eating one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
Abstinence: refraining from eating meat.

Who has to...? Fast: For members of the Latin Rite, fasting is obligatory from age 18 through 59.
Abstain: Persons age 14 onwards.



Note: persons exempt from fasting include the physically or mentally ill, individuals with chronic illness, and pregnant or nursing women.

Suy Niệm Tin Mừng

Anh chị em thân mến, bước vào Chúa Nhật I Mùa Chay, Phụng vụ dẫn chúng ta vào hoang địa, nơi Đức Giêsu ăn chay bốn mươi ngày và chịu cám dỗ trước khi khởi đầu sứ vụ rao giảng. Hoang địa là nơi tĩnh lặng, thử thách và thanh luyện. Đó cũng là hình ảnh của chính cuộc đời mỗi người chúng ta. Tin Mừng thuật lại ba cơn cám dỗ mà Chúa phải đối diện: Cám dỗ về vật chất, cám dỗ về danh vọng, cám dỗ về quyền lực. Hoang địa hôm nay có thể là những lúc cô đơn, thất bại, hay những giằng co nội tâm giữa thiện và ác. Noi gương Đức Giêsu, chúng ta vượt thắng cám dỗ bằng: Cầu nguyện sốt sắng, ăn chay và hy sinh, siêng năng đọc và song Lời Chúa, làm việc bác ái với anh chị em.

Mùa Chay không phải là mùa buồn bã, nhưng là mùa trở về. Trở về với Thiên Chúa là nguồn sống đích thực; trở về với chính mình để nhận ra những yếu đuối cần được thanh luyện; và trở về với tha nhân bằng tình yêu thương cụ thể.
