Second Sunday of Lent

March 1, 2026

The Gospel reading for the Second Sunday of Lent, Year A, recounts the transfiguration of Jesus on a high mountain. Before his three closest disciples, Peter, James, and John, his face suddenly shone brightly, and his clothes became dazzling white. Two figures from the Old Testament, Moses and Elijah, appeared and conversed with him. And from the bright cloud came the voice of God the Father: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." The transfiguration was not just a moment of glory, but a light that preceded the Passion. Jesus showed his disciples a glimpse of the glory of the resurrection, so that when they faced the cross, they would not lose faith. After contemplating the glory, the disciples had to follow their Master down the mountain, return to their ordinary lives, and prepare for the journey of suffering. Lent is also such a journey. There are times when we experience peace, fervor, and the light of faith. But there are also times when we must face challenges, suffering, and spiritual dryness. God does not promise us to remain forever on the "high mountain" of spiritual emotions, but He invites us to: trust when life is dark, be faithful when faith is tested, and listen to God's Word even when we do not fully understand His ways.

Suy Niệm Lời Chúa

Bài Tin Mừng Chúa Nhật II Mùa Chay năm A thuật lại biến cố Chúa Giêsu hiển dung trên núi cao. Trước mặt ba môn đệ thân tín là Phêrô, Giacôbê và Gioan, dung mạo Người bỗng rực sáng, y phục trở nên trắng tinh như ánh sáng. Hai nhân vật của Cựu Ước là Môsê và Êlia hiện ra đàm đạo với Người. Và từ đám mây sáng có tiếng Chúa Cha phán: “*Đây là Con Ta yêu dấu, đẹp lòng Ta mọi đàng, hãy vâng nghe lời Người.*” Biến cố hiển dung không chỉ là một khoảnh khắc vinh quang, nhưng là ánh sáng soi chiếu trước cuộc khổ nạn. Chúa Giêsu cho các môn đệ thấy trước vinh quang phục sinh, để khi đối diện thập giá, các ông không mất niềm tin. Các môn đệ vừa được chiêm ngắm vinh quang thì sau đó phải theo Thầy xuống núi, trở lại đời thường và chuẩn bị bước vào hành trình thương khó. Mùa Chay cũng là hành trình như thế. Có những lúc chúng ta cảm nghiệm được sự bình an, sốt sắng, ánh sáng đức tin. Nhưng cũng có lúc phải đối diện thử thách, đau khô, khô khan. Chúa không hứa cho ta ở mãi trên “núi cao” của cảm xúc thiêng liêng, nhưng Người mời gọi ta: Tin tưởng khi đời tối tăm, trung thành khi đức tin bị thử thách, vâng nghe Lời Chúa ngay cả khi không hiểu hết đường lối của Người.
