Gospel Reflection

The third Sunday of Lent brings us to the meaningful encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman at Jacob's well. In this very ordinary setting, a thirsty person asking for water, Jesus reveals a profound truth: humanity thirsts not only for physical thirst, but also for love, truth, and God.

The Samaritan woman came to the well at midday, perhaps to avoid the gaze of others. Her life had been filled with brokenness and guilt. Yet it was at that very well that she met the One who understood her past but did not condemn her. Jesus did not look at her with contempt, but with compassion and salvation.

In this story, we see a journey of transformation. Lent is a time for each of us to reflect on the thirst in our souls. Sometimes we try to fill it with money, success, or fleeting pleasures, but still feel empty. Only Christ can satisfy the deepest longings of humanity.

Suy Niệm Tin Mừng

Chúa Nhật III Mùa Chay đưa chúng ta đến cuộc gặp gỡ đầy ý nghĩa giữa Đức Giêsu và người phụ nữ Samaria bên bờ giếng Giacóp. Trong khung cảnh rất đời thường, một người khát nước xin nước uống, Đức Giêsu mở ra một chân lý sâu xa: con người không chỉ khát nước thể xác, mà còn khát tình yêu, khát sự thật, khát Thiên Chúa.

Người phụ nữ Samaria đến giếng vào giữa trưa, có lẽ vì muốn tránh ánh mắt của mọi người. Cuộc đời chị có nhiều đổ vỡ và mặc cảm. Thế nhưng chính nơi giếng nước ấy, chị gặp được Đấng hiểu rõ quá khứ của mình nhưng không kết án. Đức Giêsu không nhìn chị bằng ánh mắt khinh miệt, nhưng bằng ánh mắt cảm thông và cứu độ.

Trong câu chuyện này, chúng ta thấy một hành trình biến đổi. Mùa Chay là thời gian để mỗi người chúng ta nhìn lại con khát trong tâm hồn mình. Có khi chúng ta tìm cách lấp đầy bằng tiền bạc, thành công, hay những thú vui chóng qua, nhưng vẫn cảm thấy trống vắng. Chỉ có Đức Kitô mới có thể làm thỏa mãn khát vọng sâu xa nhất của con người.

Lenten suggestions for 2026 focus on combining prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to foster spiritual growth.

+ Daily Mass, Volunteer, Fast from social media or buying coffee out, Daily acts of kindness, Daily letters of gratitude, 15 minutes in silent prayer, Listen to a Bible/Rosary/Catechism in-a-year or Catholic podcast or Catholic YouTube video.

+ Donate clothes/food, offer sincere compliments, or call a friend/family member you haven't spoken to in a while.

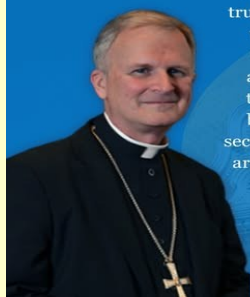
+ Read or listen to a book or video on a spiritual topic.

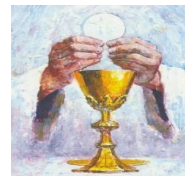
