Gospel Reflection

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is often called Laetare Sunday – the Sunday of Joy. Amidst the penitential journey of Lent, the Church invites us to pause and feel the joy of God's light shining upon each of our lives. Today's Gospel recounts Jesus healing a man blind from birth. This blind man not only had his physical sight opened, but also his faith opened, enabling him to recognize Jesus as the one who came from God. Meanwhile, the Pharisees, though their eyes were clear, were blind in spirit because they refused to believe. Lent is a time for Jesus to touch the eyes of our hearts. Through the Word of God, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and a life of prayer, God wants to open our eyes so that we may see more clearly His love and the path we must walk. By allowing God to open the eyes of our hearts, we will recognize the light of God present in our lives, and we will also become a light for those around us.

Suy Niệm Tin Mừng

Chúa Nhật IV Mùa Chay thường được gọi là Chúa Nhật Laetare – Chúa Nhật của niềm vui. Giữa hành trình sám hối của Mùa Chay, Giáo Hội mời gọi chúng ta dừng lại để cảm nhận niềm vui vì ánh sáng của Thiên Chúa đang chiếu soi cuộc đời mỗi người. Tin Mừng hôm nay kể lại việc Chúa Giêsu chữa lành một người mù từ thuở mới sinh. Người mù ấy không chỉ được mở đôi mắt thể lý, mà còn được mở mắt đức tin để nhận ra Chúa Giêsu là Đấng đến từ Thiên Chúa. Trong khi đó, những người Phariseu tuy mắt sáng nhưng lại mù lòa trong tâm hồn vì họ không muốn tin. Mùa Chay là thời gian để Chúa Giêsu chạm đến đôi mắt tâm hồn chúng ta. Qua Lời Chúa, Bí tích Hòa Giải và đời sống cầu nguyện, Chúa muốn mở mắt chúng ta để thấy rõ hơn tình yêu của Ngài và con đường chúng ta phải bước đi. Khi để cho Chúa mở mắt tâm hồn, chúng ta sẽ nhận ra ánh sáng của Chúa đang hiện diện trong đời mình, và chúng ta cũng trở nên ánh sáng cho những người chung quanh.

+What to Do for Lent? Get to Know the Lord Better.+
Author Stephen Covey reminds us to “begin with the end in mind.” What is your Goal? The goal is to become more like God, to become a saint. Knowing yourself and knowing where you need to grow, to know the Lord better, to help you become the saint God is calling you to be?
Make it simple. Jesus talks about three areas that are indispensable regarding the Christian life: prayer, fasting and almsgiving. For Lent, try to do one thing in each of these 3 areas.


