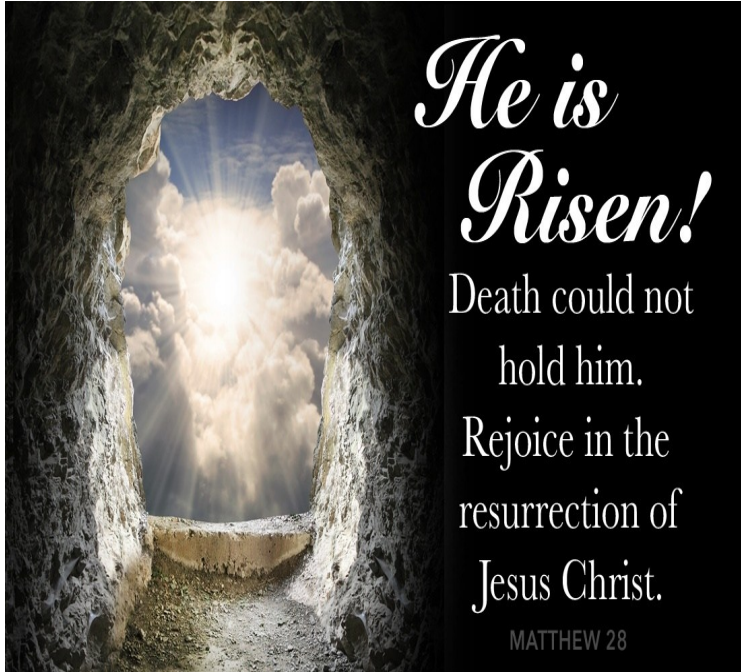

Gospel Reflection

Dear brothers and sisters, today’s Gospel recounts Mary’s arrival at the tomb “while it was still dark”, a darkness that signifies not merely the darkness of night, but also the darkness of the soul: loss, disappointment, and brokenness. This is an experience shared by each of us in our own lives. Yet, precisely at the moment when the darkness seemed most profound, God acted. The light of the Resurrection does not arrive only when everything is settled; rather, it breaks forth right within circumstances that appear utterly hopeless. The Lord continues to transform the “tombs” of our lives into the very starting points of new life.

The empty tomb: a sign of hope. The empty tomb is not a definitive proof, but rather an invitation to believe. God does not impose Himself upon us; instead, He invites us to embark upon a journey of faith.

In our lives today, we, too, encounter many “empty tombs”: Unanswered questions, sufferings that have not yet been lifted, and trials for which there seems to be no way out. Yet, it is precisely there that the Lord invites us to believe: that death does not have the final word.

Suy Niệm Tin Mừng

Anh chị em thân mến, Tin Mừng hôm nay thuật lại Maria đến mộ “khi trời còn tối” không chỉ là bóng tối của thời gian, mà còn là bóng tối của tâm hồn: mất mát, thất vọng, đổ vỡ. Đó cũng là kinh nghiệm của mỗi người chúng ta trong cuộc sống. Nhưng chính lúc tưởng chừng tối tăm nhất, Thiên Chúa đã hành động. Ánh sáng Phục Sinh không đến khi mọi sự đã ổn, mà đến ngay trong hoàn cảnh tưởng như vô vọng. Chúa vẫn đang biến đổi những “ngôi mộ” trong đời ta thành nơi khởi đầu của sự sống mới.

Ngôi mộ trống: dấu chỉ của niềm hy vọng, ngôi mộ trống không phải là bang chứng rõ ràng, nhưng là lời mời gọi tin. Thiên Chúa không áp đặt, Ngài mời gọi chúng ta bước vào hành trình đức tin.

Trong cuộc sống hôm nay, chúng ta cũng gặp nhiều “ngôi mộ trống”: Những câu hỏi chưa có lời giải, Những đau khổ chưa được cất đi, Những thử thách chưa có lối thoát. Nhưng chính ở đó, Chúa mời gọi ta tin rằng: sự chết không phải là tiếng nói cuối cùng.
