Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week—the most significant week in the liturgical year. Today’s liturgy leads us from the atmosphere of joy, as the crowds acclaimed Jesus entering Jerusalem, to the climax: His sorrowful Passion. These two contrasting images invite us to reflect upon the human condition and God’s saving love.

Today, the crowds acclaim: “Hosanna to the Son of David!”; yet, just a few days later, they cry out: “Crucify Him!” This rapid shift reflects a wavering faith and an unstable loyalty. We can easily recognize ourselves within that very crowd: following the Lord when times are favorable, yet drifting away—or even denying Him through word or deed—when difficulties arise.

In His Passion, Jesus offered Himself completely. He accepted betrayal, unjust condemnation, scourging, and crucifixion. Yet, remarkably, He neither complained nor resisted; instead, He silently submitted to the holy will of the Father. His love did not falter in the face of suffering or death. It was precisely this self-giving love that opened the path of salvation for humanity.

Chúa Nhật Lễ Lá mở đầu Tuần Thánh – tuần lễ quan trọng nhất trong năm phụng vụ. Phụng vụ hôm nay đưa chúng ta đi từ bầu khí hoan lạc khi dân chúng tung hô Chúa Giêsu tiến vào Giêrusalem, đến cao điểm là cuộc Thương Khó đầy đau thương của Người. Hai hình ảnh tương phản ấy giúp ta suy nghĩ về thân phận con người và tình yêu cứu độ của Thiên Chúa.

Đám đông hôm nay tung hô: “Hoan hô Con vua Đavít!”, nhưng chỉ ít ngày sau lại hô lớn: “Đóng đinh nó vào thập giá!”. Sự thay đổi nhanh chóng ấy phản ánh một đức tin dễ dao động, một lòng trung thành thiếu bền vững. Ta có thể dễ dàng nhận ra chính mình trong đám đông đó: khi thuận lợi thì theo Chúa, khi khó khăn lại xa Chúa, thậm chí chối bỏ Người bằng lời nói hay hành động.

Trong cuộc Thương Khó, Chúa Giêsu hoàn toàn tự hiến. Người chấp nhận bị phản bội, bị kết án bất công, bị đánh đòn và chịu đóng đinh. Nhưng điều đáng chú ý là Người không oán trách, không công trả, mà âm thầm vâng phục thánh ý Chúa Cha. Tình yêu của Người không dừng lại trước đau khổ hay cái chết. Chính tình yêu tự hiến ấy đã mở ra con đường cứu độ cho nhân loại.



Archbishop Sheen to Be Canonized This Fall

The late American Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen will be beatified on September 24, 2026, in St. Louis, Missouri, according to the Dicastery for the Causes of Saints.

After his heroic virtue was recognized, Fulton Sheen was declared Venerable in 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI. In 2019, Pope Francis authorized a decree recognizing a miracle through his intercession, clearing the path for beatification.

The future Blessed Fulton Sheen was known for his dynamic preaching, especially on television and radio. In 1951, he began hosting a weekly television series, “Life is Worth Living,” on matters of faith that attracted some 30 million viewers.

He died in New York at the age of 84, on December 9, 1979.
